CONTACT LENS FITTING FEES

Thank you for choosing the office of Dr. Frangos for your contact lens care. Our mission is to provide you with good vision, comfortable lenses and healthy eyes. Please read our contact lens policies, sign and date the bottom. By signing, you agree with our contact lens policies and agree to pay in full for any contact lens related fees.

A. 1st time contact lens wearer:

Includes fitting, training, all trial lenses and follow-up visits until prescription is finalized. All follow-up visits must be completed within 60 days of initial visit.

Standard Lenses \$160

Astigmatism or Multifocal lenses \$200

B. Refit:

A current or previous contact lens wearer, now changing to a different brand or type. Includes fitting, trial lenses and follow-up visits (1-4). All follow-ups must be completed within 60 days of the initial visit.

Standard lenses \$60-\$80

Astigmatism or Multifocal lenses \$80-\$120

C. Contact Lens Evaluation:

Required yearly when following federal regulations. Dr. Frangos will evaluate your present lenses and determine if the fit and prescription are still appropriate. Contact lens prescriptions are not the same as glasses prescriptions. Contact lenses are deemed cosmetic and not medically necessary, so this portion of the exam is not included in the routine exam fee. The evaluation must be completed within 60 days of the initial visit. This evaluation is \$30 for any type of lens.

D. Contact lens Prescription:

Your prescription is valid for one year from the date of your last eye health exam. When Dr. Frangos writes a contact lens prescription he is saying there are no ill effects from wearing the contact lenses and that is why an eye health exam is required yearly.

E. Contact Lens Ordering:

We work with a courier services that delivers most prescriptions within one to two days to our office. Please call our office to order your contacts. We offer direct mail on most brands of our lenses at no addition charge when ordering a year supply of lenses. Custom contact lenses or more complex prescriptions can take a few days or weeks to be manufactured. If you would like, we will be glad to update you on the progress of the lenses. Please ask an associate for details on your contacts, delivery services and any rebate offers.

Our staff will be happy to explain this process in further detail if you wish. We understand that fees can sometimes be confusing and we are hoping to make this process as simple as possible. Thank you.
